Dear Governor Stitt:

It is with a great deal of regret that I must advise you of my decision to retire from my office as District Attorney of District One, comprised of Cimarron, Texas, Beaver and Harper Counties, to become effective October 1, 2021.

Although I fully intended to complete this term of office, my wife and I have both been experiencing and dealing with ongoing health issues since the first of this year. I will be 72 in November and I have simply reached a point in time when I feel it is not only in my best interest but the best interest of the people of my district that I step down as District Attorney. I take this step knowing that I can leave my office in the very capable hands of George H. Leach, III, my first assistant, and other highly skilled assistant DAs and support staff.


I am hopeful that by delaying my retirement until October 1, your office will have adequate time to obtain and take all necessary steps for the application, screening, and appointment process in order to appoint my replacement before or at my retirement date, or as soon thereafter as possible. Due to limited staffing and caseloads, any extended vacancy in my office will create significant difficulties for the offices in my four counties.

You are also advised that I am currently serving as Chairman of the OSBI Commission. My position on the Commission is based upon regional distribution of commissioners and the need for

a District Attorney to be one of the members of the Commission. I will continue to function in that capacity until October 1, 2021. This will serve as my notice of resignation from the Commission as of that date. It has truly been an honor to have been able to serve on the Commission. The advancements made and those coming will continue to serve the people of this state in a tremendous way. Thank you for the opportunity to serve the people of Oklahoma and the OSBI as a commissioner.
